INFO: Puppies and kittens must be 8 weeks old, weigh over 2 pounds and be weaned. Mother dogs and cats must have their litters weaned, plus another week's delay before surgery. Dogs and cats can be spayed while in heat but there is a greater risk of complication. OMPP will pay for 24 hour flea treatment and rabies vaccination with spay/neuter, if required. OMPP does not pay for other exam fees that may be charged by the individual clinic. how to arrange your appointment with the vet. If you do not hear from us within a week of applying, please call 360-301-8142. Ideally, the pet's owner should bring the pet to the appointment to authorize the procedures to be done. If that is not possible, the owner should sign a note authorizing the surgery to be presented to the clinic by the person transporting the pet. OMPP does NOT PAY for preanesthesia testing or shots. No cosmetic or mutilating procedures (such as declawing, tail docking or ear cropping) can be done during
